

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:


- Please read all instructions carefully before assembling this Trundle.
- For your safety, assembly by two or more adults is strongly recommended.
- Keep these instructions for future use.
- Use only vendor-supplied hardware to assemble this item. Using unauthorized hardware could jeopardize the structural integrity of the item.

PRE-ASSEMBLY:

- Remove all parts and hardware from the box. Place all items on a carpeted or scratch-free work surface, as this will avoid damaging parts during assembly. The shipping box provides an ideal work surface.
- To avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware, do not dispose of any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is complete.
- Use the parts and hardware lists below to identify and separate each of the pieces included.
- The illustrations provided allow for easier assembly when used in conjunction with the assembly instructions.
- The use of power tools to aid in assembly is not recommended. Power tools can damage the hardware and split the wood.

PARTS INCLUDED:

- (A) Front Long Side Panel (x1)
- (B) Back Long Side Panel (x1)
- (C) Short Side Panel (x2)
- (D) Side Bottom Board With Protruding Edge (x2)
- (E) Middle Bottom Board With Sunken Edge (x1)
- (F) Bottom Board Support (x2)



TOOLS REQUIRED:

Phillips Head Screwdriver (not included)





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION STEPS:

- 1. On a clear surface, place the 2 Side Bottom Boards (D) with the pre-drilled holes facing upward, as seen in the illustration below.
- 2. Slot the protruding edges of the Side Bottom Boards (D) into the grooved edges of the Middle Bottom Board (E), as seen in the illustration below.




- 3. Align the pre-installed wooden dowels on the Bottom Board Support (F), with the pre-drilled holes at the bottom of the 2 Side Bottom Boards (D), as see below.
- 4. Insert 12 Screws (J) through the pre-drill holes on Bottom Board Support (F) and into the Bottom Boards (D&E), as seen in the illustration below.
- 5. Gently tighten the Screws (J) with a Philips Head Screwdriver (Not included). Do not over tighten.





- 6. Secure the 6 Casters (M) to the Side Bottom Boards (D) by inserting 24 Small Pan Head Screws 8x12mm (L) through the holes on the Casters (M) and into the pre-drilled holes on the Bottom Panels.
- 7. Gently tighten the 24 Screws (L) with a Philips Head Screwdriver (Not included). Do not over tighten.



- 8. Turn over the assembled Bottom Boards (D&E).
- 9. Slot the Long Side Panels (A & B) onto the Side Bottom Boards (D), as seen below.
- 10. Align the pre-installed wooden dowels on the Bottom Board Support (F), with the pre-drilled holes on the Panels (A&B), as seen in the illustration below.




- 11. Place 8 Barrel Nuts (I) onto the corresponding openings of each of the Long Side Panels (A & B), as seen below.
- 12. Attach the 2 Short Side Panels (C) to the Long Side Panels (A & B), by aligning the pre-installed wooden dowels of the Long Side Panels with the pre-drilled holes of the Short Side Panel, as seen in the illustration below.



- 13. Insert 8 Allen Bolts 1/4" x 63 x 13mm (H) through the pre-drilled holes of each Short Side Panel (C) and into the 8 Barrel Nuts (I), as seen in the illustration below.
- 14. Secure with the supplied Allen Key (G). Do not over tighten.




- 15. Carefully turn the assembled Trundle over.
- 16. Insert 10 Pan Head Screws 8x25mm (K) into the pre-drilled holes on the cleats of the Side Boards (A, B & C), as seen in the illustration below.
- 17. Gently tighten the Screws (K) with a Philips Head Screwdriver (Not included). Do not over tighten.



- 18. Check all alignments and gently tighten all connecting bolts at this time.
- 19. Assembly is complete.



Rory Bed (sold separately)

Note: Make sure the Side Rails of the Rory Bed are at the high position before pushing the trundle underneath.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Dust often using a clean, soft, dry, and lint-free cloth.
- Blot spills immediately and wipe with a clean, damp cloth.
- We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives, or furniture polish on our lacquered finish.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight.
 Re-tighten if necessary.
